A call to all residents of Elgin County!

You are invited to submit up to two (2) works to the Aylmer Art Exhibit.
Eligible works: painting, photography, drawing, prints, textiles, sculpture.

Please note: your artwork must be ready to install (i.e. mounted, framed, attachments for hanging) and properly labelled with your name and phone number (make sure label is securely attached).

Step 2	Drop off your artwork (maximum 2 items per person) at the Aylmer Resource Centre (16 Talbot St East, Aylmer, ON).	Tuesday, October 16 th , 2018 10am – 5pm
Step 3	See your work exhibited! Bring your friends and family! Admission is free.	Thursday, October 18 th , 2018, 1-8pm
Step 4	Pick up your artwork at the Old Town Hall Theatre. MCS will not be responsible for the storage of artworks after October 18 th , 2018.	Thursday, October 18 th , 2018, 8-9pm

Aylmer Art Exhibit Additional Information



1) Who is eligible to participate in the Aylmer Art Exhibit?

To be eligible for this exhibition, you must be a current resident of Elgin County.

2) If I am an Elgin County resident, are my family or friends outside of Elgin County eligible to submit artwork?

Friends or family members who reside outside of Elgin County are NOT eligible to submit artwork, but are very welcome to come view the exhibit.

3) What kind of artwork do you accept?

We accept:

- Paintings that are either ready to hang or be propped up (for example, works on canvas must be outfitted with a wire or in a frame with a stand or on an easel)
- Framed drawings, prints, or photographs that are either ready to hang or be propped up
- Textiles that are either ready to hang or be displayed flat
- Sculptures or woodwork

Please note: if your artwork falls outside this criteria, please contact MCS at 519-765-3020. There may be an opportunity for you to display your art at the Aylmer Art Exhibit.

4) How do I submit my artwork to be in the Exhibition?

To apply for your art to be in the Aylmer Art Exhibit:

- Fill out the submission form on page 1
- Attach a well-lit and clear photograph of the work(s) you are submitting
 - Either an online attachment image via e-mail or a hard-copy photograph

All submissions will be reviewed by an evaluation board. If your work is chosen to be in the Aylmer Art Exhibition we will contact you at the phone number or e-mail you provided in your submission form.

5) When can I drop off my artwork?

Your artwork can be dropped off on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 between 10:00am and 5:00 pm at the Aylmer Resource Centre (16 Talbot Street East, Aylmer, ON)

If you are not able to come in during the allotted time period, please contact MCS at 519-765-3020.

6) When can I pick up my artwork?

Your artwork can only be picked up on Thursday, October 18th between 8:00 pm and 9:00 pm.

Please note: MCS does not accept any responsibility for the storage of your artwork after October 18th at 9pm.
