Job Title:	Mom&Baby Outreach Worker (Prenatal Care)
<b>Starting Date:</b>	Immediately
Job Summary:	The Family Education and Support Project of Aylmer (FESPA) is one of the programs at Mennonite Community Services. The Mom & Baby Outreach Worker will provide group teaching and home visits for pregnant mothers helping them achieve enhanced health for themselves and their babies.
Core Competencies:	The Outreach Worker will have good verbal communication skills in English and Low German. She needs a high level of interest in prenatal health. She needs to be aware and sensitive of the Low German culture and have the ability to listen to, reassure and encourage her clients. She must be able to work under pressure, willing to attend births, and willing to advise and instruct clients. She needs to use her own vehicle to travel to client homes.
Core Job Duties:	The Outreach Worker must work as a team member with the Family Support Worker and the FESPA Manager. She will make regular home visits with each client, provide group teaching, distribute food cards and vitamin vouchers, attend births to translate and encourage mothers, communicate with Support Worker to provide excellent care to mothers and babies, and make referrals to medical professionals.
Requirements and Qualifications:	Excellent verbal communication skills in English and Low German required; appreciation and understanding of Low German culture; develop a healthy relationship of trust with the clients; use her own vehicle; ability to work as a team; model non-violent peacemaking; postsecondary education required; participate in staff meetings and MCS events; be willing to work some weekends and evenings.  **In-person duties altered as per COVID health & safety guidelines.**
