Pronunciation Guide

The pronunciation provided in brackets is based on English sounds and pronunciation.

All the vowels in brackets are considered short unless marked long with a dash.

“au”	sounds like the “o”	in grow (notated <i>ō</i>)
“ee”	sounds like the “igh”	in right (notated <i>ī</i>)
“ei”	sounds like the “eh”	in “meh”
“o”	can sound like the “u”	in cup (notated <i>u</i>)
“o”	can sound like the “oo”	in room (notated <i>ōō</i>)
“oo”	sounds like the “ou”	in out
“u”	can sound like the “u”	in bush (notated <i>u</i>)
“u”	can sound like the “u”	in cute (notated <i>ü</i>)
“j”	sounds like the “y”	in yam
“jch”	sounds like the “h”	in huge (notated <i>jch</i>)
“ch”	can sound like the “h”	in huge (notated <i>jch</i>)
		(like the “h” in ham and the “y” in yam pronounced together in one sound: <i>hy</i>)
“ch”	can sound like the “j”	in jalapeño (notated <i>ch</i>)
“kj”	sounds like “ky” (the “y” as a consonant, like in <i>yam</i> , <u>not</u> like in <i>lucky</i>) (the “j” behind the “k” softens the hard “k”)	
“ch” and “jch”	do not have any English equivalent.	
The hard “ch”	sounds like the “j”	in jalapeño (notated <i>ch</i>)
The soft “ch” (also written “jch”)	is softer and is not guttural (not in the throat)	
Note:	The soft and hard “ch” sounds in Low German are like in [high] German.
